Established by the **ministries of education** from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia

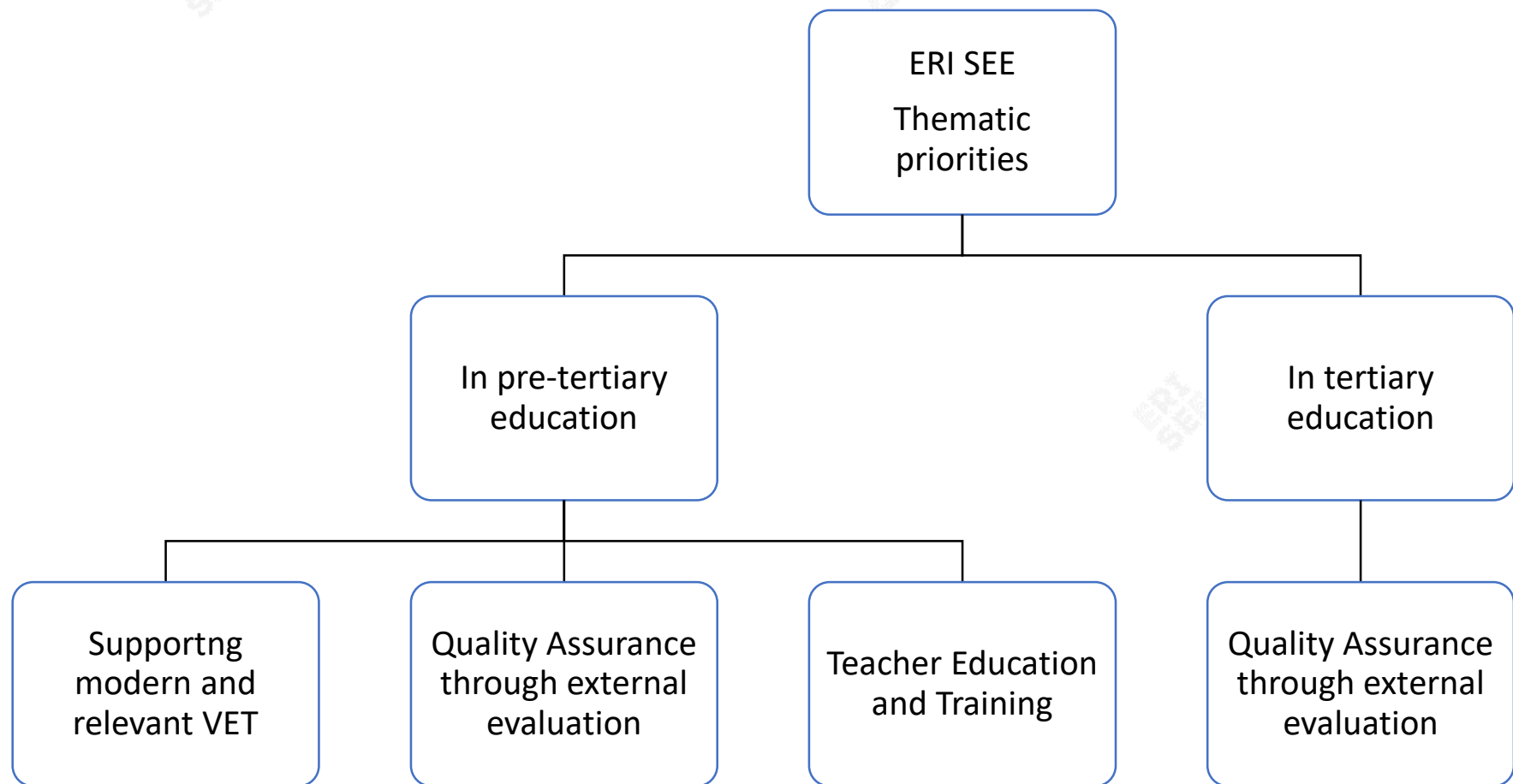
Mandated to **enhance regional cooperation** in education and training with the purpose of supporting national educational reform processes in participating economies

Implementing body: **ERI SEE Secretariat**, seated in Belgrade

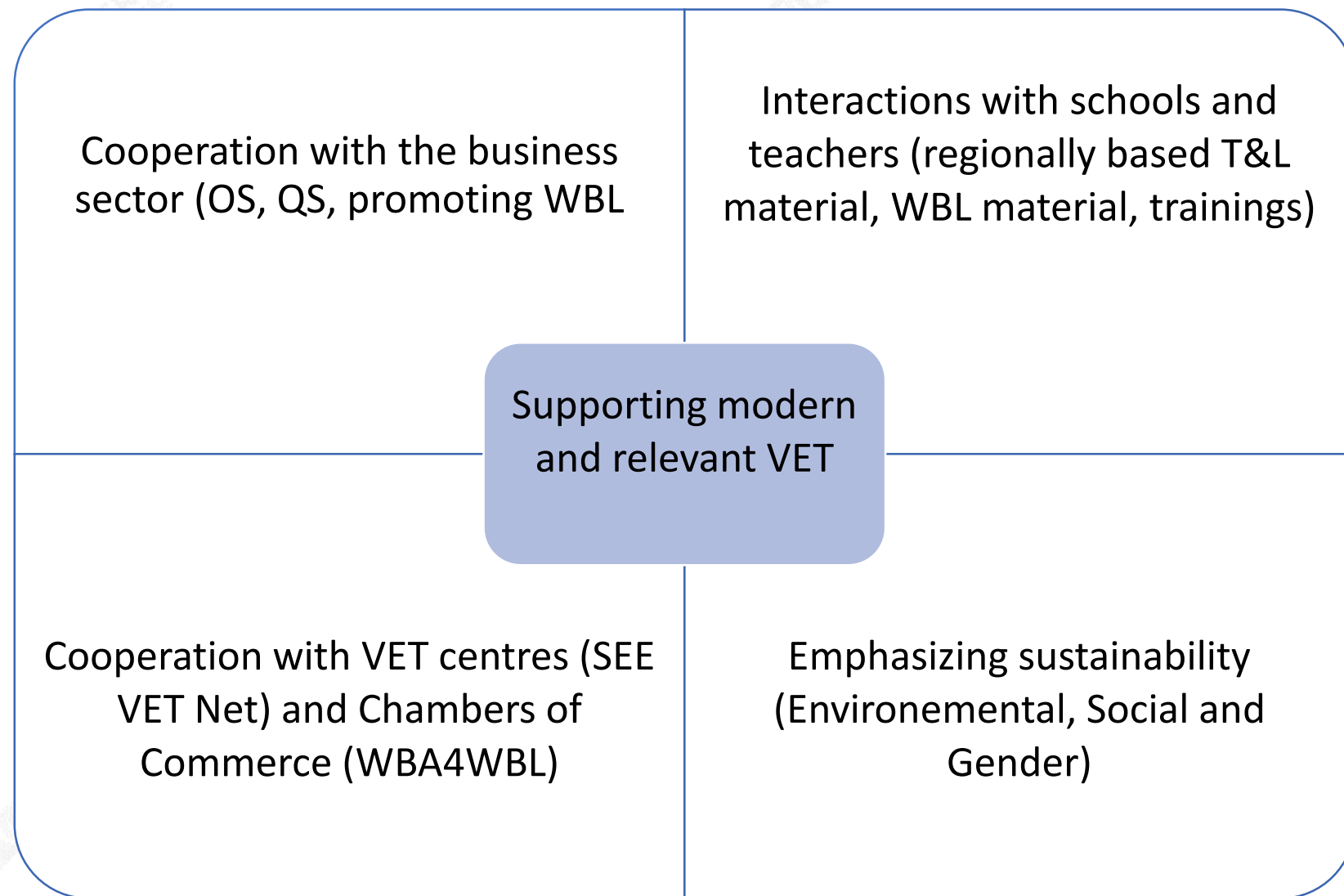

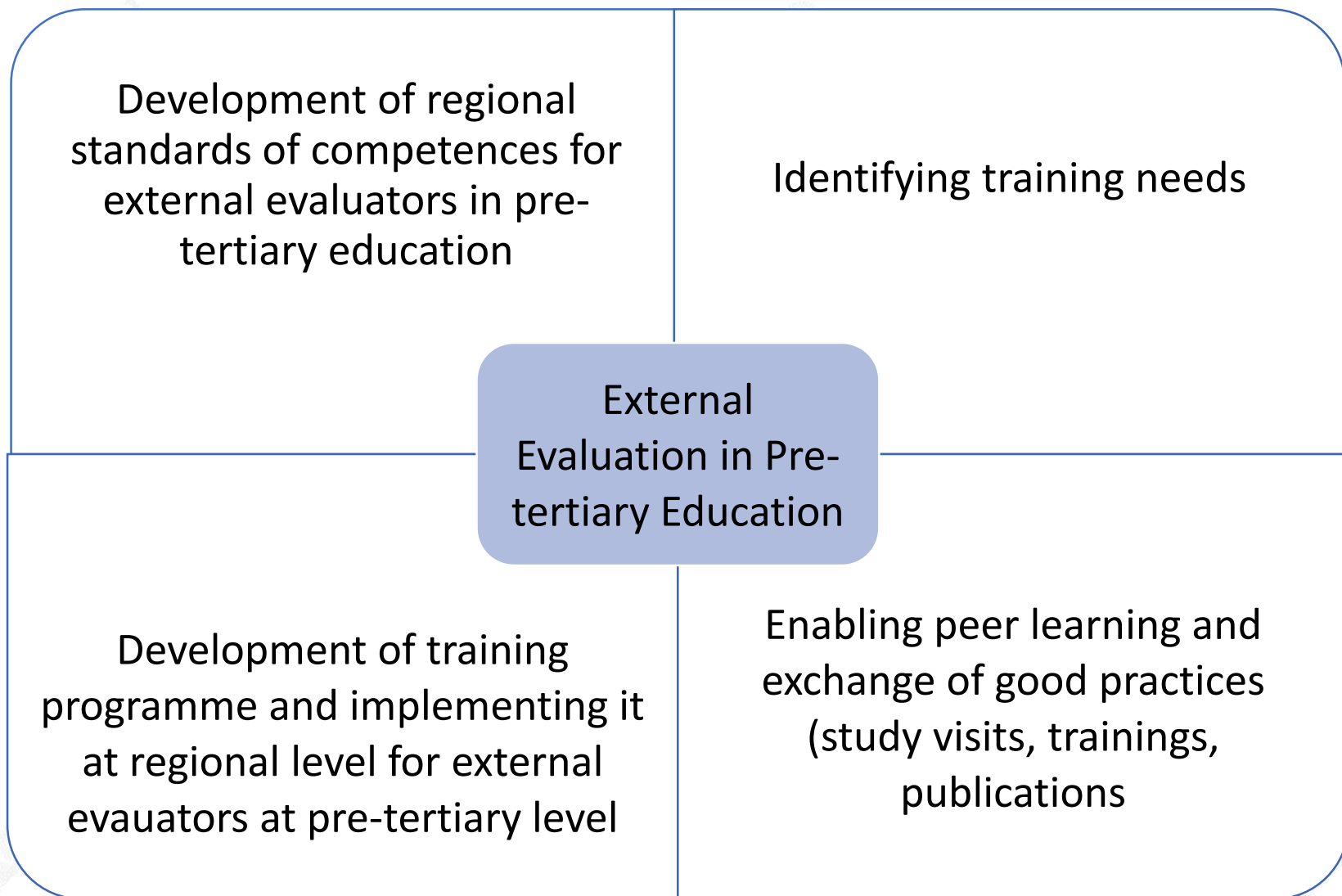

Development of training programme and implementing it at regional level for external evaluators at pre-tertiary level

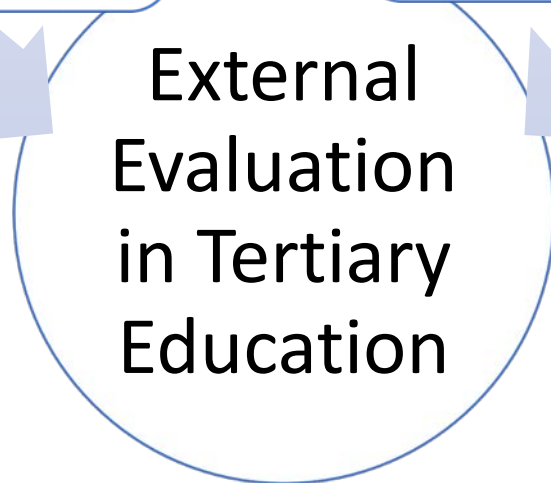
Enabling peer learning and exchange of good practices (study visits, trainings, publications)

Peer learning opportunities for agencies for quality assurance in tertiary education, with focus on European Standards and Guidelines (conferences, study visits, trainings)

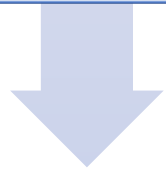
Enhancing availability of data in tertiary education (register of accredited HEIs in the Western Balkans)





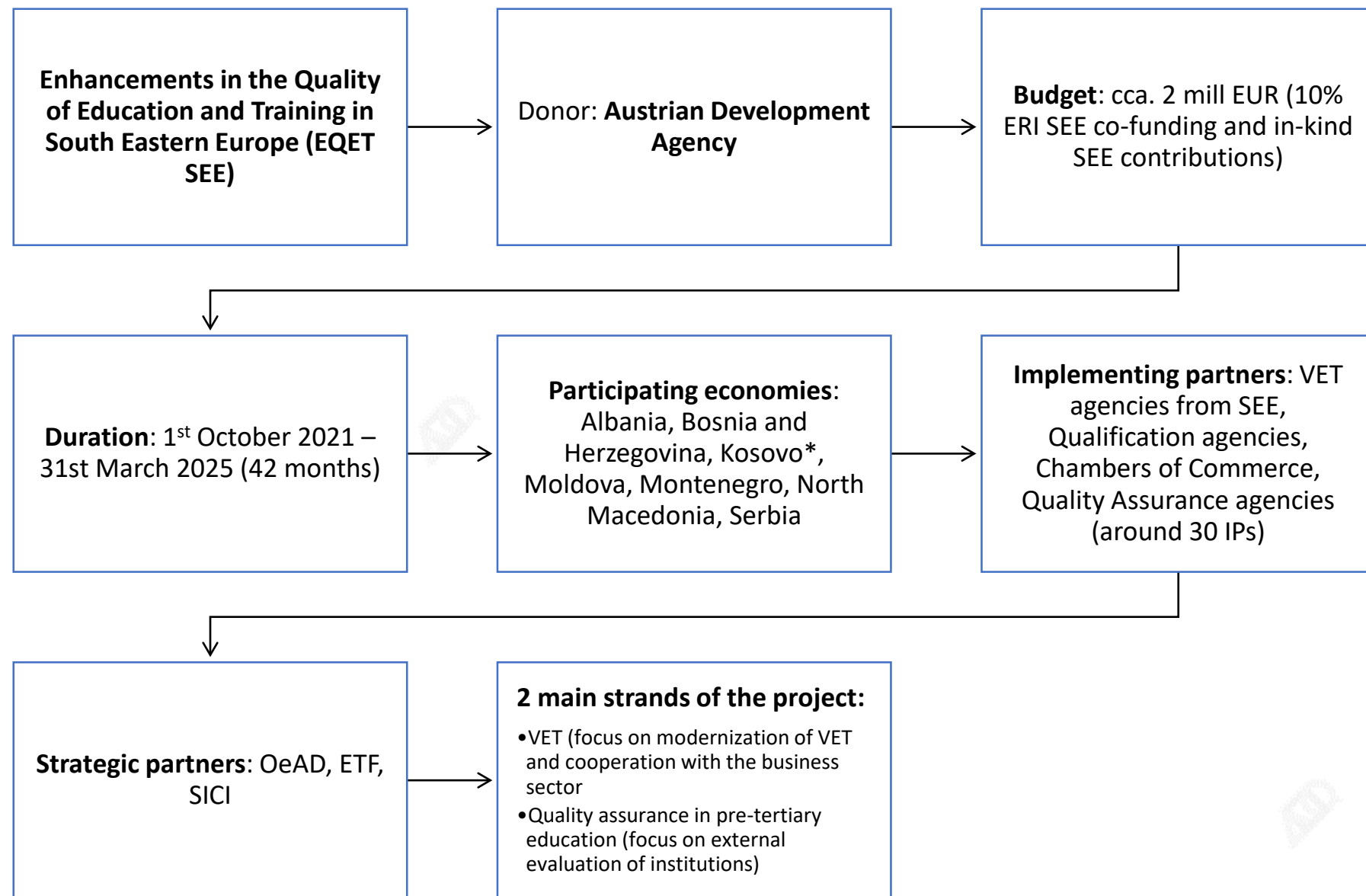

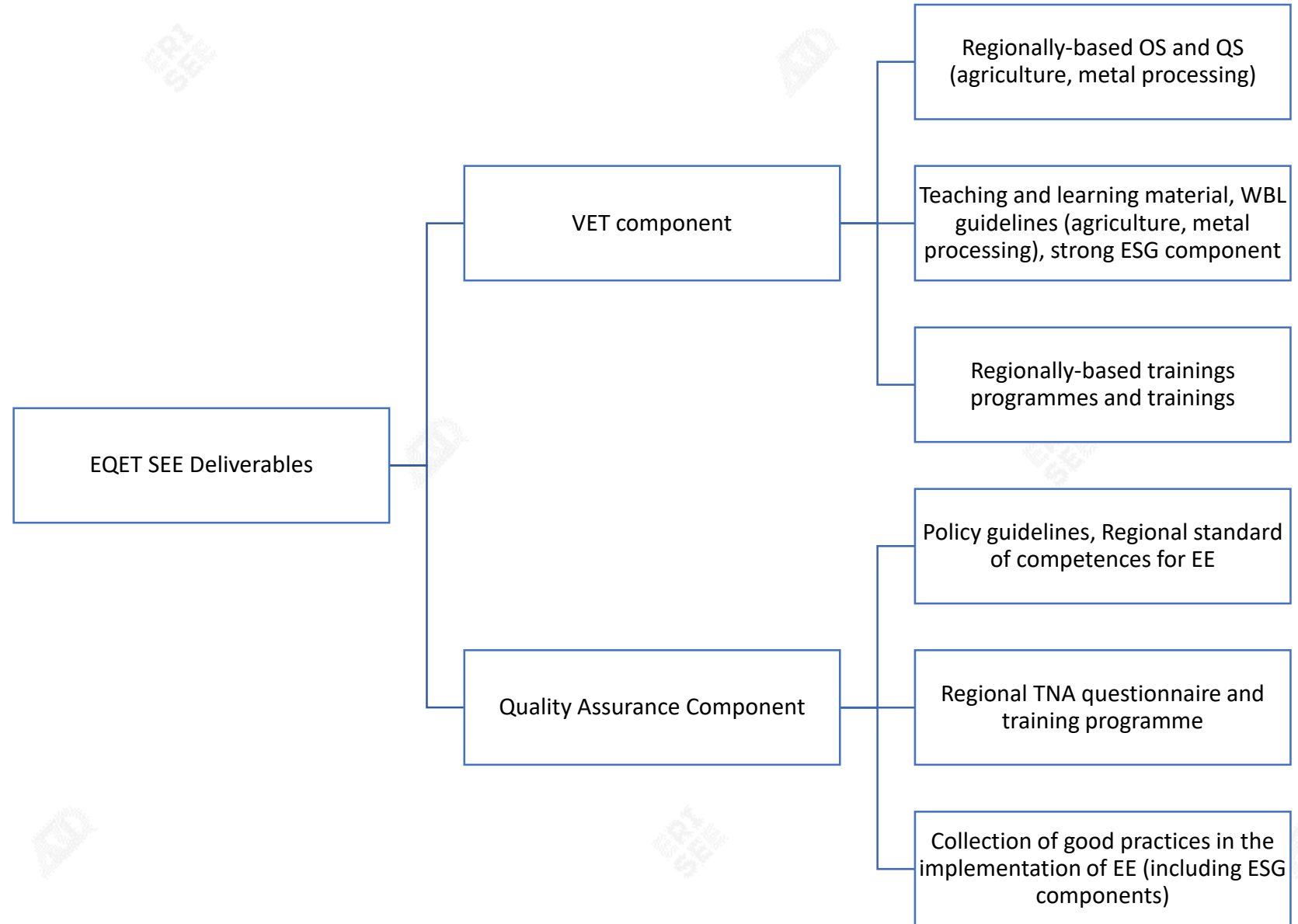

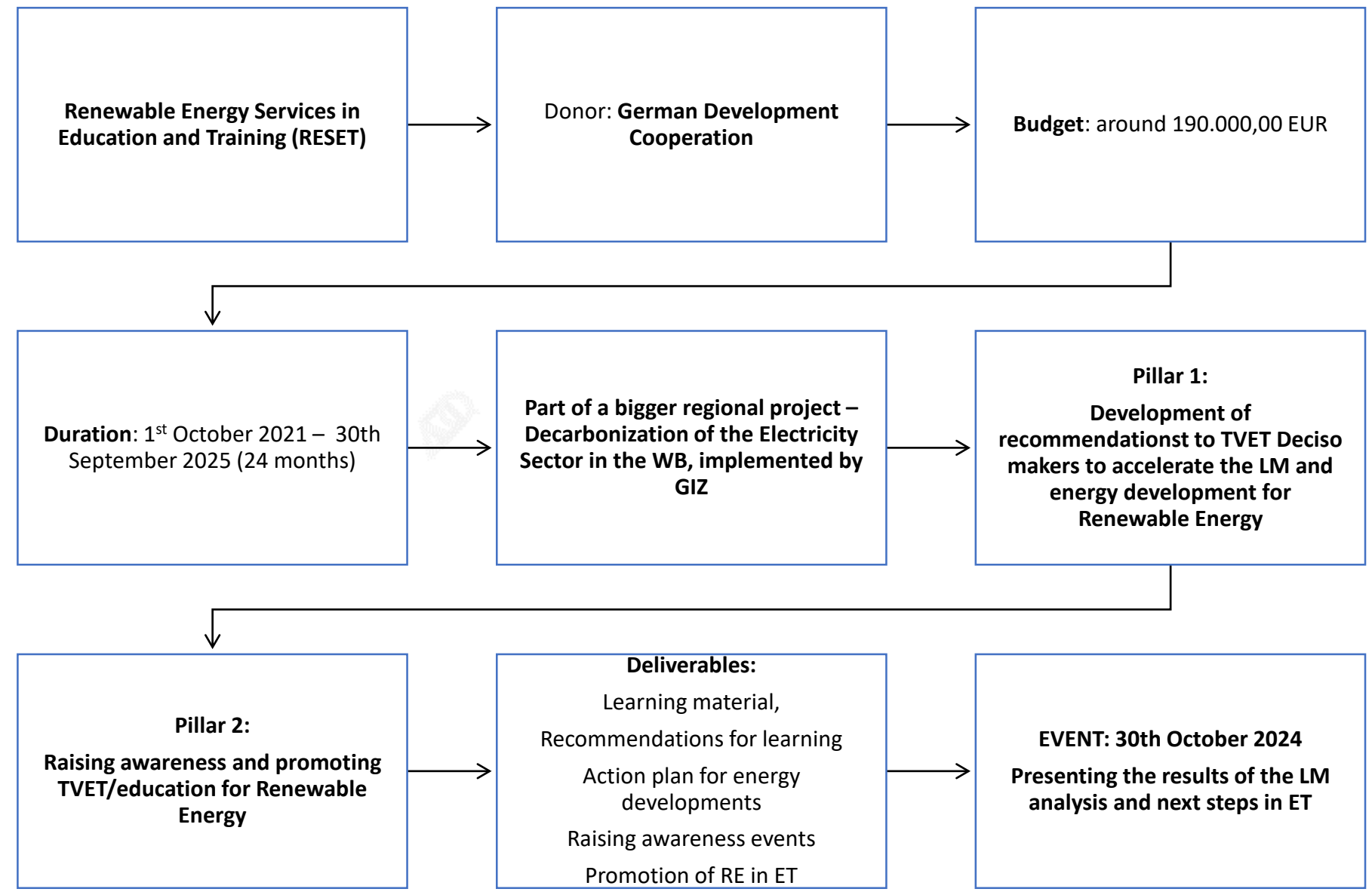


Deliverables of the EQET SEE project
